

PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the donation of contractor services, materials, and appliances for the remodeling of the Los Angeles Police Department's (LAPD) Hollywood Area employee break room.

Recommendation for Council action:

AUTHORIZE the LAPD to accept a the donation of contractor services, materials, and appliances valued at \$44,702 from the Alliance Residential Company for the remodeling of the LAPD's Hollywood Area employee break room, and THANK the donor for this generous gift.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the LAPD. Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

SUMMARY

In a report to the Board of Police Commissioners dated September 6, 2013 (attached to the Council file), LAPD requests authority to accept a donation of contractor services, material, and appliances for the remodeling of the Hollywood Area's employee break room. The donation consists of appliances, plumbing, carpentry, countertop, cabinets, tiles, paint, flooring, and electrical supplies. On September 10, 2013, the Board approved LAPD's request.

At its meeting held November 8, 2013, the Public Safety Committee recommended that Council authorize LAPD to accept this donation and thank the donor for this generous gift.
