

ORDINANCE NO. 182682

An ordinance establishing a specific plan, known as the Jordan Downs Urban Village Specific Plan, relating to a portion of the Southeast Los Angeles Community Plan area generally bounded by 97th Street to the north, Alameda Street to the east, 103rd Street to the south, and Grape Street to the west.

**THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LOS ANGELES
DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:**


Section 1. The City Council hereby establishes and adopts the attached Jordan Downs Urban Village Specific Plan for the area bounded by heavy dashed lines, as shown on the Jordan Downs Urban Village Specific Plan Boundaries Map (Map 1) contained in the Specific Plan.

Sec. 2. The City Council finds that the adoption and efficacy of this ordinance are required for the immediate protection of public peace, health and safety, and implementation of the development contemplated in the Specific Plan requires funding from a variety of local, state and federal sources, and it is essential that this ordinance take effect in time to accommodate the applications for those funding sources. For that reason, this ordinance shall become effective upon publication, pursuant to Section 253 of the Los Angeles City Charter.


Sec. 3. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this ordinance and have it published in accordance with Council policy, either in a daily newspaper circulated in the City of Los Angeles or by posting for ten days in three public places in the City of Los Angeles: one copy on the bulletin board located at the Main Street entrance to the Los Angeles City Hall; one copy on the bulletin board located at the Main Street entrance to the Los Angeles City Hall East; and one copy on the bulletin board located at the Temple Street entrance to the Los Angeles County Hall of Records.

I hereby certify that this ordinance was passed by the Council of the City of Los Angeles, by a vote of not less than three-fourths of all of its members, at its meeting of AUG 14 2013.


