TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE REPORT and RESOLUTION relative to renewing Temporary Preferential Parking District (TPPD) No. 87 near Pico Boulevard and Curson Avenue, and authorizing additional parking restrictions.

Recommendations for Council action:

1. FIND that the parking problems that led to the establishment and renewals of TPPD No. 87, located near Pico Boulevard and Curson Avenue, still exist, and that no permanent solution has been found.
2. AUTHORIZE use of "NO PARKING 8 AM - 6 PM, MONDAY TO SATURDAY; VEHICLES WITH DISTRICT NO. 87 PERMITS EXEMPT" on both sides of all streets in TPPD No. 87, except where parking is currently prohibited at all times in the interest of traffic flow or safety.
3. ADOPT the accompanying RESOLUTION authorizing the above parking restriction and renewing TPPD No. 87 for 12 months, until September 29, 2014, pursuant to Section 80.58.d of the Los Angeles Municipal Code, at which time it will be subject to the administrative renewal process.

Fiscal Impact Statement: LADOT reports that the cost of implementing, administering, and enforcing TPPD No. 87 will be covered by the revenue from the sale of permits for the District. Furthermore, the City may gain additional General Fund revenue from the issuance of parking citations to violators of the District's parking restrictions.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

In the March 28, 2013, report to Council, LADOT recommends that TPPD be renewed and that additional parking restrictions be approved. According to LADOT, TPPD No. 87 was established September 29, 2003. Residents have requested an additional restriction, "NO PARKING 8 AM - 6 PM, MONDAY TO SATURDAY; VEHICLES WITH DISTRICT NO. 87 PERMITS EXEMPT", be authorized to address their needs. The Councilmember for the 10th District supports the renewal of the TPPD and the additional parking restriction. A map of the Temporary PPD is attached to the Council file. At its meeting held April 10, 2013, the Transportation Committee recommended that Council approve this matter.

RESOLUTION

RENEWAL OF TEMPORARY PREFERENTIAL PARKING DISTRICT NO. 87 NEAR PICO BOULEVARD AND CURSON AVENUE AND AMENDMENT TO AUTHORIZED RESTRICTIONS

WHEREAS, on August 14, 2003, the Council adopted a Resolution (CF 03-2155) establishing Temporary Preferential Parking District (PPD) No. 87, and which is currently due to expire on September 29, 2013; and

WHEREAS, Councilmember Wesson states that the conditions that originally justified this Temporary PPD; which include regular intrusion of vehicles associated with businesses on Pico Boulevard, still exist, and no other viable measure to resolve the resulting parking intrusion into the neighborhood is available; and

WHEREAS, Councilmember Wesson has requested that an additional restriction: "No Parking 8 AM to 6 PM, Monday to Saturday, Vehicles with District No. 87 Permits Exempt" parking restriction be added to the preferential parking restrictions authorized for use anywhere within this District; and

WHEREAS, Councilmember Wesson has requested the renewal of Temporary PPD No. 87 to provide continued relief to the residents of the District from the adverse parking impact they were experiencing prior to the establishment of the District; and

WHEREAS, Los Angeles Municipal Code Section 80.58.d authorizes Temporary PPDs to be renewed on an annual basis by resolution until either a permanent solution is found or the problem ceases to exist.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that upon adoption of this Resolution by the Council, the following preferential parking restriction be added to the list of parking restrictions authorized for use anywhere within the District except for areas where parking is currently prohibited at all times in the interest of traffic flow or safety:

"No Parking 8 AM to 6 PM; Monday to Saturday, Vehicles with District No. 87 Permits Exempt"; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Council, pursuant to Los Angeles Municipal Code Section 80.58.d, hereby renews Temporary PPD No. 87 for an additional 12 months until September 29, 2014; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that all other terms and conditions of Temporary PPD No. 87 remain unchanged.
