

MOTION

On April 5, 2018, the Board of Harbor Commissioners approved a one-year Foreign Trade Zone (FTZ) Operating Agreement between the Harbor Department and California Cartage Company, LLC (California Cartage) to continue operating its warehouse within FTZ 202, Site 1A, located at 2401 East Pacific Highway, Wilmington, CA 90744.

The current FTZ Operating Agreement No. 17-3536 between the Harbor Department and California Cartage will expire on April 29, 2018. California Cartage has requested to continue its warehouse operations at Site 1A, which consists of 600,000 square feet of warehouse and office space.

Action is needed to assert jurisdiction to allow further review of the above matter.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the Council determine, as provided in Section 54954.2(b)(2) of the Government Code, and pursuant to **Rule 23** of the Rules of the City Council, that there is a need to take immediate action on this matter AND that the need for action came to the attention of the City Council subsequent to the posting of the agenda for today's Council meeting.

I FURTHER that pursuant to Los Angeles City Charter Section 245, the City Council assert jurisdiction over the Board of Harbor Commissioners' April 5, 2018 action relative to the approval of a one-year Foreign Trade Zone Operating Agreement between the Harbor Department and California Cartage Company, LLC.


I FURTHER MOVE that upon assertion of jurisdiction, Council refer the matter to Committee for further review.
