Summary: The Reseda Neighborhood Council supports the proposed changes to the JEDI program which include: 1) Adjusting the qualifying criteria to allow businesses on both sides of a boundary street to qualify for the benefits of the JEDI Zone program, so long as one side of the street qualifies under the primary eligibility criteria. 2) Adjusting the qualification of an economic assessment from meeting five of eight secondary needs criteria to needing to meet four of six secondary needs criteria. We believe these common sense changes will help allow neighborhoods to gain JEDI status while keeping commercial corridors whole. We also believe this proposed change would greatly benefit the Reseda community which currently has a JEDI zone designation pending before the City Council.
