

PUBLIC WORKS AND GANG REDUCTION COMMITTEE REPORT relative to agreements with the State of California, Department of Transportation (Caltrans) and the Los Angeles Dodgers necessary for the painting and ongoing maintenance of the Chinatown Pedestrian Bridge over the Pasadena Freeway.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Cedillo - Bonin):

REQUEST the City Attorney, in coordination with the Department of Transportation, to prepare and present the necessary agreements with Caltrans and the Los Angeles Dodgers for the painting and ongoing maintenance of the Chinatown Pedestrian Bridge over the Pasadena Freeway.
