SUMMARY

At its meeting held August 22, 2018, the Transportation Committee considered the Mayor's reappointment of Mr. John Ly to the Board of Transportation Commissioners. Mr. Ly was in attendance and expressed his desire to continue serving the community as a member of the Board. As a member of the Board, Mr. Ly endeavors to aid the Los Angeles Department of Transportation to recruit new employees to replace retiring staff. Mr. Ly also discussed the importance of the Board's role as a driver of long-term and specialty transportation projects. The nominee further stated that the Board can take a greater role on policy issues such as the approval of preferential parking districts and identifying municipal parking lots to provide overnight parking for homeless persons living in their vehicles. Committee recommended that Council approve the Mayor's reappointment of Mr. Ly to the Board of Transportation Commissioners.
