WHEREAS, a Special Election was ordered to be held in the City of Los Angeles pursuant to Ordinance No. 182331 to place a measure before the voters and the election was consolidated with the City of Los Angeles Primary Nominating Election held March 5, 2013; and

WHEREAS, the following measure was submitted to a vote of the qualified voters of the City of Los Angeles:

NEIGHBORHOOD PUBLIC SAFETY AND VITAL CITY SERVICES FUNDING AND ACCOUNTABILITY MEASURE. PROPOSITION A

To offset severe and repeated State cuts and provide funding for: 911 emergency response services; maintaining firefighter, paramedic, and police officer staffing levels; continuing community policing, senior services, after-school gang and drug prevention programs; repairing potholes and sidewalks; and other general municipal services; shall the City of Los Angeles enact a one-half cent transactions and use (generally referred to as sales) tax, with required independent audits, public review of expenditures, and all funds used locally?

WHEREAS, the Los Angeles City Clerk, in accordance with City of Los Angeles Charter Section 404, did canvass the returns of the Primary Nominating Election held in the City of Los Angeles on March 5, 2013, and certified them to the City Council; and

WHEREAS, it appears to the City Council that the canvass of votes is true and correct.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Los Angeles City Council hereby finds, determines, and declares that the total number of votes cast for and against City of Los Angeles Proposition A at the Special Election by the qualified voters was 337,559 as set forth in the certification of the Los Angeles City Clerk, and that the measure, as proposed by Resolution of the City Council, is hereby declared to not have been approved by a majority of the voters voting thereon.

FIRE AND POLICE PENSION PLAN; COST NEUTRAL PURCHASES OF RETIREMENT CREDIT BY CERTAIN MEMBERS. CHARTER AMENDMENT B
Shall the Charter be amended to authorize the City Council to allow sworn police personnel who are transferred from the Department of General Services to the Police Department to purchase, at their own expense, retirement credit for prior sworn City service after they become members of the Fire and Police Pension Plan?

WHEREAS, the Los Angeles City Clerk, in accordance with City of Los Angeles Charter Section 404, did canvass the returns of the Primary Nominating Election held in the City of Los Angeles on March 5, 2013, and certified them to the City Council; and

WHEREAS, a Special Election was ordered to be held in the City of Los Angeles pursuant to Resolution No. 4 of the Burbank Unified School District and the Resolution adopted by the City Council on November 11, 2012 (Council File 13-1100-S1) to place a measure before the voters and the election was consolidated with the City of Los Angeles Primary Nominating Election held March 5, 2013; and

WHEREAS, the following measure was submitted to a vote of the qualified voters of the Burbank Unified School District:

BURBANK SCHOOLS IMPROVEMENT MEASURE. MEASURE S.

To improve the quality and safety of Burbank school facilities, to upgrade classrooms, computers and technology, to replace aging portable classrooms, electrical systems, plumbing and sewer lines, roofs and play areas, to improve student safety and security including upgraded fire protection, increase energy efficiency and to provide accessibility for students with disabilities, shall Burbank Unified School District be authorized to issue \$110,000,000 in bonds, at legal rates, with independent citizens oversight and annual audits?

WHEREAS, the Los Angeles City Clerk, in accordance with City of Los Angeles Charter Section 404, did canvass the returns of the Primary Nominating Election held in the City of Los Angeles on March 5, 2013, and certified them to the City Council; and
