As recommended in the accompanying report of the City Engineer, which this Board has adopted, the Board of Public Works recommends that the City Council review and consider the final Van Nuys Fire Station 39 Project Environmental Impact Report (EIR), and that the City Council:

1. Certify that the Van Nuys Fire Station No. 39 Final EIR (Transmittal No. 1) was completed in compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA); and that the Final EIR was presented to the Council, as the decision-making body of the City of Los Angeles, and that the Council has reviewed and considered the information contained in the Final EIR; and that the Final EIR reflects and expresses the City independent judgment and analysis.
2. Adopt the CEQA Findings of Fact (Transmittal No. 2).
3. Adopt the Mitigation Monitoring Program (Transmittal No. 3).
4. Specify that the documents constituting the record of proceedings in this matter area in the custody of the City Clerk located at 200 North Spring Street, Los Angeles, CA 90012 and that the files of the Department of Public Works, Bureau of Engineering, located at 1149 South Broadway, Suite 600, Los Angeles, CA 90015.
5. Approve the Project as described in the Final EIR.

FISCAL IMPACT

The proposed Project has a construction budget of approximately \$20,200,000 with funding from the surplus Proposition F Fire Facilities General Obligation Board Program savings, program contingency, and accrued interest.
