

MOTION

I HEREBY MOVE that Council ADOPT the following recommendations relative to an application for determination of "Public Convenience or Necessity" for alcohol sales for off-site consumption at CVS Pharmacy and retail market located at 4030 South Western Avenue (Item No. 9, Council file No. 13-1112):

1. DETERMINE that the issuance of a liquor license at CVS Pharmacy and retail market located at 4030 South Western Avenue, Los Angeles, 90062, will serve the "Public Convenience or Necessity" and will not tend to create a law enforcement problem.
2. GRANT the application for Determination of "Public Convenience or Necessity" for the sale of alcoholic beverages for off-site consumption at 4030 South Western Avenue.
3. INSTRUCT the City Clerk to transmit this determination to the State Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control as the required findings under Business and Professions Code Section 23958.4.
4. AMEND the application for Determination of "Public Convenience or Necessity", question No. 14(b), to be more specific as it relates to security concerns and to reflect that the store and property owners have stated that: security guards will be in place 7 days per week from 9:00am to 10:00pm in all common areas; that one security guard will be in place 7 days per week from 9:00am to 10:00pm in the internal store; and, that the store will have a full complement of security cameras.
