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CATEGORICAL EXEMPTION and TRADE, COMMERCE, AND TOURISM COMMITTEE REPORT relative to proposed Foreign-Trade Zone (FTZ) General Purpose Operating Agreement with NNR Global Logistics USA, Inc., FTZ 202, Site 29.

Recommendations for Council action:

1. ADOPT the determination by the Los Angeles Harbor Department that the proposed action is exempt under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) as provided in Article III, Section 1(14) of the Los Angeles City CEQA Guidelines.
2. APPROVE the FTZ General Purpose Operating Agreement with NNR Global Logistics USA, Inc., FTZ 202, Site 29.

Fiscal Impact Statement: The City Administrative Officer (CAO) reports that approval of the proposed FTZ Operator Agreement with NNR Global Logistics USA Inc., will provide for an administrative fee of \$5,000 per year, for five years, and a total fee of \$105,000, if the contract is renewed for three five-year renewal options, for a total of 20 years. There will be no impact on the City General Fund. All Funds will be deposited in the Harbor Revenue Fund.

SUMMARY

At a regular meeting held on September 10, 2013, your Trade, Commerce and Tourism Committee considered a Harbor Department transmittal relative to proposed FTZ Operating Agreement No. 13-3117 with NNR Global Logistics USA Inc., in FTZ No. 202, Site No. 29, located in the City of Carson, approximately ten miles from the Port. The proposed operating agreement with NNR is for an initial term of five years, with three subsequent five-year renewal options, for a contract term up to a total of 20 years. The FTZ Operator plans to operate and manage an office building and also distribution and general warehouse facilities at Site No. 29. An opportunity for public comment was held. After a brief discussion, the Committee moved to approve the recommendations contained in the transmittal. This matter is now forwarded to the Council for its consideration.
