

COMMUNICATION FROM CHAIR AND MEMBER, BUDGET AND FINANCE COMMITTEE relative to requesting a report on the impacts to the City of any potential future shutdowns of the federal government.

Recommendation for Council action, as initiated by Motion (Blumenfield - Wesson - LaBonge - Englander):

DIRECT the City Administrative Officer (CAO), with the assistance of the Chief Legislative Analyst (CLA), to report in early December 2013 on the impacts to the City of the failure to have a federal budget in place in time for the beginning of the federal fiscal year, which begins on October 1, and the resulting shutdown of the federal government, and any potential future shutdowns of the federal government.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the CAO nor the CLA has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

At its regular meeting of October 21, 2013, the Budget and Finance Committee considered a Motion requesting a report on the impacts to the City of the failure to have a federal budget in place in time for the beginning of the federal fiscal year and the resulting federal shutdown. The Motion states that this year the City is budgeted to receive more than \$457 million in federal funds which are used to support a wide range of services to the people of Los Angeles. The Motion concludes that a comprehensive assessment of the shutdown's impact on City operations is needed so that the impact on the City and residents can be minimized. After consideration and having provided an opportunity for public comment, the Chair and Member of the Budget and Finance Committee recommended approval of the Motion as amended to request a report in early December on the impacts of any potential future shutdowns of the federal government. This matter is now submitted to Council for its consideration.
