# RESOLUTION

## ESTABLISHMENT OF OVERSIZE VEHICLE RESTRICTED STREETS IN THE MAR VISTA AREA NEAR VENICE BOULEVARD AND SAWTELLE AVENUE

WHEREAS, California Vehicle Code Section 22507 authorizes cities to restrict the parking of vehicles, including but not limited to, vehicles that are six feet or more in height, on identified City streets, during certain hours; and

WHEREAS, the Los Angeles Municipal Code Section 80.69.4 allows the City Council to authorize by Resolution, the streets upon which the parking of oversize vehicles shall be restricted between 2:00 AM and 6:00 AM; and

WHEREAS, the Mar Vista community is experiencing public health and safety issues on various streets that are the direct result of large vehicles parking on-street overnight and include: the reduction in the width of the roadways that leads to diminished visibility and increased congestion, as well as sanitation issues related to the dumping of raw sewage onto the roadway;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council, pursuant to the Los Angeles Municipal Code Section 80.69.4, hereby prohibits the parking of vehicles that are in excess of 7-feet in height, or 22-feet in length, during the hours of 2:00 AM to 6:00 PM, on both sides of the following street segments:

- Purdue Avenue between Charnock Road and Francis Place
- Purdue Avenue between Francis Place and Regent Street
- Purdue Avenue between Regent Street and Victoria Avenue
- Regent Street between Purdue Avenue and dead end east of Purdue Avenue
- Berryman Avenue between Francis Place and Victoria Avenue
- Francis Place between Berryman Avenue and Purdue Avenue
- Charnock Road between Butler Avenue and Coolidge Avenue
- Charnock Road between Butler Avenue and Purdue Avenue
- Charnock Road between Purdue Avenue and Corinth Avenue
- Charnock Road between McLaughlin Avenue and Coolidge Avenue
- Victoria Avenue between Purdue Avenue and Butler Avenue
- Victoria Avenue between Butler Avenue and Berryman Avenue
- Victoria Avenue between Berryman Avenue and dead end west of Berryman Avenue; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that upon the adoption of this Resolution, the Department of Transportation be directed to post the appropriate signs giving notice of a "Tow Away, No Parking" overnight parking restriction at the above locations; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that upon adoption of this Resolution, that the Department of Transportation be directed to initiate the necessary procedures for the preparation and sale of overnight parking permits, as specified in Los Angeles Municipal Code section 80.69.4.(c); and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Transportation be authorized to make any technical corrections or clarifications to the above instructions in order to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.
