Summary: On 09/25/2019, the BABCNC held a Brown-Act publicly-noticed board meeting, and with a quorum of 22, the board considered what would be the appropriate measurements for the Mexican Elderberry and Toyon, and unanimously recommended keeping existing measurements as for other protected trees, namely, that they measure four inches or more in cumulative diameter, four and one-half feet above the ground level at the base of the tree. At the 02/26/2020 BABCNC board meeting, by a vote of 23/0/0, the board requested that the city hold a hearing and move the ordinance forward to adoption.
