

TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE REPORT and RESOLUTION relative to renewing Temporary Preferential Parking District (TPPD) No. 150 and modifying the District's boundaries.

Recommendations for Council action:

1. FIND that the parking problems that led to the establishment and renewals of TPPD No. 150 still exist and have expanded to the 700 block of Radcliffe Avenue, and that no permanent solution has been found.
2. FIND that the expansion and renewal of TPPD No 150 is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) as a Class 1 Categorical Exemption under Article 111, 1, a, 3 of the 2002 Los Angeles City CEQA Guidelines.
3. ADOPT the accompanying RESOLUTION amending the boundaries of the district to include the 700 block of Radcliffe Avenue and renewing TPPD No. 150 for 12 more months, until September 30, 2015, pursuant to Section 80.58.d of the Los Angeles Municipal Code at which time it will again be subject to the administrative renewal process.

Fiscal Impact Statement: LADOT reports that revenue from the sale of Preferential Parking Permits will cover the cost of implementation and administration of TPPD No. 150. The City will gain additional General Fund revenue from the issuance of parking citations to violators of the TPPD's parking restrictions.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

In a report dated October 31, 2013 (attached to the Council file), LADOT recommends that Council renew TPPD No. 150 and approve the modification of the District's boundaries to include the 700 block of Radcliffe Avenue. According to the LADOT, since the administrative renewal of the TPPD on September 30, 2012, the residents on the 700 block of Radcliffe Avenue have requested and petitioned to be included in the District because of the substantial negative impact from non-residents parking in the area. A map of the modified TPPD is attached to the Council file. The Council Office has expressed support for the renewal and expansion of the TPPD.

At its special meeting held December 4, 2013, the Transportation Committee recommended that Council approve the above actions to renew and modify TPPD No. 150, as recommended by LADOT.
