Garfield Place between Hollywood Boulevard and Franklin Avenue in Council District 13 is a residential street that also serves as a feeder street to Hollywood Boulevard. On the northwest corner of Hollywood Boulevard and Garfield Place, Meta Housing Corporation constructed a 120-unit affordable senior housing development which enriches the community. As part of the mitigation measures for the housing project, Meta Housing Corporation was required to construct speed humps on Garfield Place between Hollywood Boulevard and Franklin Avenue. The project and its proposed mitigations were approved by The Central Los Angeles Area Planning Commission on April 22, 2008. Speed humps are an effective tool to slow down vehicular traffic and can improve the pedestrian environment on a residential street, and are needed on Garfield Place.

The City discontinued its speed hump program in the 2009/2010 budget as a result of funding constraints. Meta Housing Corporation has offered to pay costs associated with the preparation of design/bid package for the speed humps to meet the City's criteria. Meta Housing Corporation will construct the speed humps at its own cost through an appropriate permit process.


