

MOTION ARTS, PARKS, HEALTH, AGING & RIVER

In November 2013 a motion was introduced by Councilmembers Price and Huizar (CF 13-1493) instructing the Chief Legislative Analyst (CLA) to report with recommendations to create a regulatory system to effectively permit street vending. Since then the Economic Development Committee has heard the item several times, and requested further study by the CLA, including gathering of community input.

Given that the City is currently undergoing these efforts to develop a street vending program, there should be a similar effort in regards to City parks, as well as outreach to the public in regards to the recently proposed changes governing vending at City parks and recreational facilities.

WE THEREFORE MOVE that the City Council instruct Department of Recreation and Parks to work with the CLA on the citywide effort to address the regulation of street vending, per CF 13-1493, and to develop a compatible permit process for vending in City parks and recreational facilities.

WE FURTHER MOVE that the City Council instruct Department of Recreation and Parks to immediately engage in a public outreach and education campaign to inform the community of any changes to City law in regards to vending at City parks and recreational facilities.
