Brief Summary: The Northridge East Neighborhood Council opposes the legalization of vendors selling food and merchandise on sidewalks and parkways within the public right-of-way. The Los Angeles Municipal Code, Section 42.00 (b), prohibits commercial "street vending." 
Board Resolution of Action

Parkways**



I, Glenn Bailey, declare that I am the President of the Northridge East Neighborhood Council and that on August 19, 2015, a Brown Act noticed regular meeting was held by the Northridge East Neighborhood Council with a quorum of 9 board members present and that by a vote of 8 yes, 1 no, 0 abstentions, the Northridge East Neighborhood Council adopted the following resolution:
