RECOMMENDATIONS:

DISCUSSION:

The petitioner, City Of Los Angeles, is requesting that the City-owned property lying on the northeast sideline of San Fernando Road southeast of Treadwell Street, shown hatched on attached Exhibit Map, be dedicated as Public Street.

The dedication is necessary to complete the public street dedication required on the northeast sideline of San Fernando Road southeast of Treadwell Street, for Major Highway-Class II, pursuant to Section 12.37 of the Municipal Code.

ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION:

The Bureau of Engineering has determined that this dedication of City-owned land as Public Street, is categorically exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act of 1970, under Article III, Class 5(4) of the City's Environmental Guidelines.
