r from public use various streets and roadways

In 1936, the Council took an action to withdraw from public use various streets and roadways (Ordinance No. 76896), including Arcos Drive, between Alatar Drive and Galendo Street, in Woodland Hills. This portion of Arcos Drive is in severe need of resurfacing, but the City only services public use streets and roadways.

Ordinance No. 76896 also provides that the City may return any of the withdrawn streets to public use when it has been determined that any such street is safe and in a passable condition.

The City Engineer and the Bureau of Street Services should expeditiously determine the current condition of Arcos Drive and to report on the steps needed to reinstate this street as a public street.

ITHEREFORE MOVE that the City Engineer and the Bureau of Street Services be directed to report on the current roadway condition of Arcos Drive between Alatar Drive and Galendo Street, in Woodland Hills, which was withdrawn from pubic use in 1936 under Ordinance No. 76896, and to report on the steps necessary to reinstate Arcos Drive as a public street.
