

PUBLIC WORKS AND GANG REDUCTION COMMITTEE REPORT relative to reinstating Arcos Drive, between Alatar Drive and Galendo Street in Woodland Hills, as a public street.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Blumenfield - Englander):

INSTRUCT the City Engineer and the Bureau of Street Services to report on the current roadway condition of Arcos Drive, between Alatar Drive and Galendo Street in Woodland Hills, which was withdrawn from public use in 1936 under Ordinance No. 76896, and to report on the steps necessary to reinstate Arcos Drive as a public street.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

At a regular meeting held on August 20, 2014, the Public Works and Gang Reduction Committee considered a Motion (Blumenfield - Englander) relative to reinstating Arcos Drive, between Alatar Drive and Galendo Street in Woodland Hills, as a public street. An opportunity for public comment was held. After a brief discussion, the Committee moved to approve the recommendation contained in the Motion as detailed above.
