MOTION


In 1936, the City Council took an action by ordinance (No. 76896) to withdraw from public use various streets and roadways in the City, including the Woodland Hills community. Many of these withdrawn streets and roadways are now in severe need of maintenance and repair, but the City can only service public use streets and roadways.

Ordinance No. 76896 also provides that the Board of Public Works may return any of the withdrawn streets to public use when it has been determined that any such street is safe and in a passable condition. The Ordinance further states that the withdrawal action is not to be construed as vacation or abandonment of the rights of the City to such streets.

With the passage of time, there is now a need for the Department of Public Works to expeditiously determine the conditions of the streets and roadways within Council District 3 that were withdrawn from public use and to report on the actions necessary to reinstate such streets and roadways as public streets.


**I THEREFORE MOVE** that the Department of Public Works be directed to prepare and present a report on the condition of the streets and roadways withdrawn from public use in 1936 under Ordinance No. 76896 within Council District 3, and to report on the steps necessary to reinstate such streets and roadways as public streets.
