

PUBLIC WORKS AND GANG REDUCTION COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the reinstatement of Escobedo Drive in Woodland Hills.

Recommendation for Council action, as initiated by Motion (Blumenfield - Buscaino):

1. ADOPT the joint report from the Bureaus of Engineering and Street Services relative to accepting Escobedo Drive between Dumetz Road and Lopez Street into the City's street system and thereby return Escobedo Drive within those limits to public use.
2. REAFFIRM that reinstatement of any additional streets identified in Ordinance 76896 be processed in accordance with Section 3 of Ordinance 76896 which authorizes the Board of Public Works to reinstate listed streets into public use when found to be in a safe and passable condition.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the Bureaus of Engineering and Street Services. Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

At a regular meeting held on May 21, 2014, the Public Works and Gang Reduction Committee considered a joint report from the Bureaus of Engineering and Street Services relative to the current condition of Escobedo Drive in Woodland Hills, which was withdrawn from public use, and steps needed to reinstate Escobedo Drive as a public street. An opportunity for public comment was held. After a brief discussion, the Committee moved to approve the recommendations contained in the joint report as detailed above. This matter is now forwarded to the Council for its consideration.
