PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the re-appropriation of funds for Fiscal Year (FY) 2013-14 for the 2010 and 2011 Urban Areas Security Initiative (UASI) grant awards for Los Angeles Regional Interoperable Communications System (LA-RICS) project staff.

Recommendations for Council action, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:

1. RESOLVE that position authority for one Police Officer III (Class Code 2214-3) within the Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD) for the LA-RICS project is APPROVED, subject to paygrade determination by the Employee Relations Division of the Office of the City Administrative Officer (CAO).

2. AUTHORIZE the Controller to:

a. Transfer appropriations within the FY 2010 UASI Fund 53V/46, as follows:

h. Transfer cash from Fund 53V/46 and Fund 54M/46 to reimburse the General Fund on an as-needed basis, upon presentation of proper documentation from the LAFD, LAPD, and Information Technology Agency, subject to the approval of the Mayor's Office of Homeland Security and Public Safety.

3. AUTHORIZE the Mayor, or designee, to prepare Controller instructions for any technical adjustments, subject to the approval of the CAO; and, AUTHORIZE the Controller to implement the instructions.

Fiscal Impact Statement: The CAO reports that this action will not impact the General Fund. Approval of the above recommendations will allow for the continued expenditure of FY 2010 and 2011 UASI grant awards. These actions are in compliance with City financial policies in that grant funds are sufficient to support the grant activities.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

In a report to the Mayor and Council dated February 13, 2014 (attached to the Council file), the CAO states that the Mayor requests authority to re-appropriate fund savings from the 2010 and 2011 UASI grant awards in support of LA-RICS project staff. The CAO reports that a total of \$154,314.04 is requested to partially fund three positions: one existing Fire Captain II in the LAFD, one existing Police Sergeant I in the LAPD, and one new Police Officer III in the LAPD. The CAO recommends approval of the Mayor's requests.

At its meeting held January 24, 2014, the Public Safety Committee recommended that Council approve the Mayor's request to re-appropriate UASI grant funds, as recommended by the CAO, and as amended to incorporate a technical correction, as shown above.
