

PUBLIC WORKS AND GANG REDUCTION COMMITTEE REPORT relative to establishing guidelines and policies to allow for the display and removal of temporary street memorials being placed in the public right-of-way.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Englander - Buscaino):

INSTRUCT the Bureau of Street Services and the Bureau of Sanitation to report to the Public Works and Gang Reduction Committee, to establish compassionate guidelines and policies to allow for the display and removal of temporary street memorials being placed in the public right-of-way.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

At a regular meeting held on January 15, 2014, the Public Works and Gang Reduction Committee considered a Motion (Englander - Buscaino) relative to establishing guidelines and policies to allow for the display and removal of temporary street memorials being placed in the public right-of-way.
