



MOTION

Since the Transportation Committee's December 11, 2013 action to authorize the Department of Transportation to apply for a Traffic Safety Grant, the California Office of Traffic Safety has revised the grant application guidelines by limiting applicants to one-year of funding. The Department is revising their application and will reduce the grant funding requested, as required by the new grant application guidelines.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the consideration of the Communication from the Transportation Committee relative to an application for the 2014 Traffic Safety Grant award for a high school bicycle safety program, Item #36 on today's Council agenda (C.F. 13-1628), BE AMENDED to delete the existing recommendation and replace it with the following new recommendation:

AUTHORIZE the Department of Transportation to submit an application to the California Office of Traffic Safety (OTS) for a Traffic Safety Grant to support a one-year high school bicycle safety education program for an amount up to \$300,000 for the City's Teen Bike Safety Program, and, if the grant is awarded, accept funds and execute any necessary agreements with OTS.
