MOTION

The Department of Transportation is piloting the installation of Rectangular Rapid Flash Beacons (RRFB) to enhance pedestrian safety at intersections throughout the City. RRFBs are flashing lights that supplement warning signs at unsignalized intersections or mid-block crosswalks. These new devices have shown a high rate of motorist compliance when coupled with the installation of a crosswalk.

The intersection of Magnolia and Blakeslee in the North Hollywood community is an important component of the walkability of the area, and is an appropriate location to enhance pedestrian safety through the installation of a RRFB.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the Council instruct the Department of Transportation to install Rectangular Rapid Flash Beacons (RRFB) at the crosswalk at Blakeslee and Magnolia.
