

RULES, ELECTIONS AND INTERGOVERNMENTAL RELATIONS COMMITTEE REPORT and RESOLUTION relative to establishing the City's position to support AB 1658 which would require consumer credit reporting agencies to place a security freeze on credit reports of foster children under the age of 17.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Resolution (Koretz - Krekorian), SUBJECT TO THE CONCURRENCE OF THE MAYOR:

ADOPT the accompanying RESOLUTION to include in the City's 2013-14 State Legislative Program SUPPORT for AB 1658 (Jones-Sawyer), which would protect foster children against the fraudulent use of their identities by requiring consumer credit reporting agencies to place a security freeze on credit reports of foster children under the age of 17.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the Chief Legislative Analyst (CLA). The City Administrative Officer has not completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary

At its regular meeting of August 15, 2014, the Rules, Elections and Intergovernmental Relations Committee considered a CLA report and Resolution (Koretz - Krekorian) relative to establishing the City's position to support AB 1658 (Jones-Sawyer), which would protect foster children against the fraudulent use of their identities by requiring consumer credit reporting agencies to place a security freeze on credit reports of foster children under the age of 17. The CLA report, attached to the Council file, provides a summary of the Resolution and additional background information.
