

RULES, ELECTIONS AND INTERGOVERNMENTAL RELATIONS COMMITTEE REPORT and RESOLUTION relative to the City's position to support for AB 2673 (Bradford).

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Resolution (Wesson - Buscaino - Englander), SUBJECT TO THE CONCURRENCE OF THE MAYOR:

ADOPT the accompanying RESOLUTION to include in the City's 2013-14 State Legislative Program SUPPORT for AB 2673 (Bradford), which would prohibit the civil compromise of a misdemeanor when a driver fled the scene of a collision.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the Chief Legislative Analyst (CLA). The City Administrative Officer has not completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

At its regular meeting of May 16, 2014, the Rules, Elections and Intergovernmental Relations Committee considered a CLA report and Resolution (Wesson - Buscaino - Englander) relative to the City's position to support for for AB 2673 (Bradford), which would prohibit the civil compromise of a misdemeanor when a driver fled the scene of a collision. The CLA report, attached to the Council file, provides a summary of the Resolution and additional background information.
