

RULES, ELECTIONS AND INTERGOVERNMENTAL RELATIONS COMMITTEE REPORT and RESOLUTION relative to establishing the City's position regarding increased funding for the federal government's Countering Violent Extremism (CVE) program.

Recommendation for Council action, as initiated by Resolution (O'Farrell - Englander), SUBJECT TO THE CONCURRENCE OF THE MAYOR:

ADOPT the accompanying revised RESOLUTION to include in the City's 2015-16 Federal Legislative Program SUPPORT for the federal government's CVE program, which is based on a grassroots strategy with a significant focus on cooperation and coordination with local law enforcement and community groups, including support for any grant programs, training, and legislative efforts that are parts of the CVE program.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the Chief Legislative Analyst. The City Administrative Officer has not completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

At its special meeting of January 23, 2015, the Rules, Elections and Intergovernmental Relations Committee considered Resolution (O'Farrell - Englander) and a CLA report relative to establishing the City's position for the federal government's CVE program, which is based on a grassroots strategy with a significant focus on cooperation and coordination with local law enforcement and community groups. The CLA report, attached to the Council file, provides additional background information and a summary of the Resolution.

During Committee consideration, a revised Resolution was provided to reflect the current legislative program year. After further consideration and having provided an opportunity for public comment, the Committee recommended that Council adopt the accompanying revised Resolution. This matter is now submitted to Council for its consideration.
