SUBJECT: TRANSMITTAL OF THE GRANT APPLICATION AND AWARD FOR THE
2014 INTERNET CRIMES AGAINST CHILDREN TASK FORCE
CONTINUATION PROGRAM

RECOMMENDED ACTIONS

1. That the Board of Police Commissioners (Board) REVIEW and APPROVE this report.
2. That the Board TRANSMIT the attached grant application and award, pursuant to Administrative Code Section 14.6(a), to the Mayor, Office of the City Administrative Officer (CAO), Office of the Chief Legislative Analyst and to the City Clerk for Committee and City Council consideration.
3. That the Board REQUEST the Mayor and City Council to:
 - A. AUTHORIZE the Chief of Police or his designee to ACCEPT the supplemental award of funds for the 2014 Internet Crimes Against Children Task Force Continuation Program in the amount of \$640,890 for the period of July 1, 2014, through June 30, 2015, from the Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention, United States Department of Justice;
 - B. AUTHORIZE the Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD) to spend up to \$640,890 in accordance with the grant award agreement;
 - C. AUTHORIZE the Chief of Police or his designee to negotiate and execute the Cooperative Agreement, subject to City Attorney approval as to form and legality;
 - D. AUTHORIZE the LAPD to submit grant reimbursement requests to the grantor and deposit grant receipts in Fund No. 339, Department No. 70;
 - E. AUTHORIZE the Controller to increase the grant receivable in Fund No. 339 by the amount of \$640,890;
 - F. AUTHORIZE the LAPD to appropriate \$640,890 to appropriation account number to be determined within Fund No. 339, Department No. 70, for disbursement of the 2014 Internet Crimes Against Children Task Force Continuation Program;

- G. AUTHORIZE the Controller to increase appropriations for 2014 Internet Crimes Against Children Task Force Continuations Program as needed from appropriation account number to be determined in Fund No. 339, Department No. 70, to Fund No. 100, Department No. 70, account number and amount as follows:

Account No. 001012, Sworn Salaries:	\$ 118,352
Account No. 001090, Civilian Overtime	\$ 23,000
Account No. 001092, Sworn Overtime:	\$ 99,684

- H. AUTHORIZE the Controller to transfer appropriation within Fund No. 339, Department No. 70, for the related costs:

- I. AUTHORIZE the Chief of Police or his designee to negotiate and execute either new agreements or to amend any agreements with affiliate task force agencies, subject to the approval of the City Attorney; and
- J. AUTHORIZE the LAPD to prepare Controller Instructions for any technical adjustments, subject to the approval of the CAO, and AUTHORIZE and INSTRUCT the Controller to implement the instructions.

DISCUSSION

Funds provided under this program are intended to:

- Ensure that local law enforcement agencies are better equipped to investigate computer crimes against children by offenders using the Internet, on-line communication systems, and other technologies;
- Provide educational programs for law enforcement officers, teachers, parents, and children;
- Serve as a forensic resource to law enforcement agencies within the service area;
- Prosecute cases at the local, state and federal level; and,
- Participate in nationally-coordinated investigations.

The LAPD will allocate \$118,352 for salaries, \$99,684 for sworn overtime, \$23,000 for civilian overtime, \$65,106 for fringe benefits, \$64,540 for travel, \$25,367 for equipment, \$20,084 for supplies, \$56,581 for consultants, and \$168,176 for other costs.
