DISCUSSION

The DART program is a collaboration of community members and sworn personnel who advocate for victims of domestic violence and their families. The donation will pay for Rainbow Consulting Services, a domestic violence advocate. Rainbow Services offers victims immediate crisis intervention and emergency assistance at the onset of the abusive event and will continue throughout the investigative and judicial process. It increases victim safety and cooperation from the initial investigation through prosecution. Furthermore, it decreases recidivism and improves the perception of the Department by domestic violence victims.

No expressed or implied commitments or promises were made to the donor or representatives of the donor. The donor will not receive any preferential treatment, endorsement, or recommendation; and the donor is not allowed the use of any Los Angeles Police Department patents.

Administrative Services Bureau has reviewed the donation and determined that it has been submitted in accordance with Section 5.467 et seq. of the Los Angeles Administrative Code, which provides for the receipt and acceptance of donations to the Los Angeles Police Department.




