

PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the donation of military items for use by the Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD).

Recommendation for Council action:

AUTHORIZE the LAPD to accept the donation of military items, valued at \$298,418.33, from the Federal Excess Property 1033 Program, and THANK the donor for this generous gift.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the LAPD. Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Officer has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

In a report to the Board of Police Commissioners dated January 3, 2014 (attached to the Council file), LAPD requests authority to accept the donation of military items. The donated equipment consists of 98 ACOG scopes, 17 pairs / hot weather boots, 128 field packs, 73 sleeping bags, 10 cold weather shirt, and two nonexpendable shelters. The Department reports that the equipment will be distributed to various Departmental entities to enhance operational capabilities. On January 7, 2014, the Board approved LAPD's request.

At its meeting held February 14, 2014, the Public Safety Committee recommended that Council authorize LAPD to accept this donation.
