It is requested that Administrative Services Bureau approve and forward this correspondence to the Board of Police Commissioners to accept the donation of \$352,652 from the Los Angeles Police Foundation to fund the purchase of 8,000 trauma kits.

DONATION

The donation will provide the Los Angeles Police Department with 8,000 trauma kits to be issued to sworn field officers and new recruits for use during medical emergencies. The original trauma kits were issued in 1998, and according to Supply Division, there are less than 400 trauma kits in stock. It is anticipated that there will be no trauma kits for issuance in approximately one year.

PURPOSE

The objective of obtaining this equipment is to restock the diminishing supply of trauma kits with the up to date medical equipment that may save lives of both community members and officers. The new kits will contain face shields, gloves, adhesive tape, a modern tourniquet, compression bandages to control arterial bleeding in extremities, and a FOX chest seal occlusive bandage to treat penetrating wounds. By providing the new trauma kits to officers, they will be better prepared for future medical emergencies and it will save lives.


