

ADMINISTRATIVE EXEMPTION and TRADE, COMMERCE, AND TOURISM COMMITTEE REPORT relative to proposed tenth amendment to the permit with Yusen Terminals for container terminal operations at Berths 211-224.

Recommendations for Council action:

1. ADOPT the determination by the Los Angeles Harbor Department that the proposed action is exempt under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) as provided in Article II, Section 2(f) of the Los Angeles City CEQA Guidelines.
2. APPROVE the tenth amendment to the permit with Yusen Terminals for container terminal operations at Berths 211-224.

Fiscal Impact Statement: The City Administrative Officer (CAO) reports that approval of the proposed tenth amendment to Permit No. 692 with Yusen Terminals Inc. will not result in a fiscal impact to the Harbor Revenue Fund. Approval of the proposed resolution will not impact the City's General Fund.

SUMMARY

At a regular meeting held on January 28, 2014, your Trade, Commerce and Tourism Committee considered a Harbor Department transmittal relative to Resolution No. 13-7150 for the proposed tenth amendment to Permit No. 692 with Yusen Terminals Inc. The CAO reports that Yusen is a major container shipping tenant at the Harbor Department operating under a 25-year permit through September 30, 2016, with one ten-year renewal option that requires at least 24 months advanced notice (by August 2014) prior to expiration of its permit. An opportunity for public comment was held. After a brief discussion, the Committee moved to approve the recommendations contained in the transmittal. This matter is now forwarded to the Council for its consideration.
