

MOTION

I MOVE that the matter of the Continued Consideration of Protests, Categorical Exemption and Public Works and Gang Reduction Committee Report relative to the vacation of Exposition Boulevard (south roadway) and the Bronson Avenue Vacation District (VAC - E1401236), Item No. 6 on today's Council Agenda (CF 14-0117) **BE AMENDED** to adopt the following revisions to the conditions contained in the City Engineer's report dated March 23, 2017:

Condition 6.a.1

Construct a standard cul-de-sac at the northerly terminus of Bronson Avenue, with integral curb and gutter and 11-foot wide sidewalk.

Revise to:

Construct a standard cul-de-sac at the northerly terminus of Bronson Avenue, with integral curb and gutter and 11-foot wide sidewalk where feasible.

Explanation – The prior approved street vacation required a 10-ft wide sidewalk. Metro has reviewed the location and an 11-foot wide sidewalk will not physically fit at the end of the cul-de-sac.

Condition 6.c.2

Repair or replace any broken or off-grade concrete sidewalk, curb and gutter. Close all unused driveways with full height curb, 2-foot gutter, and sidewalk.

Revise to:

Repair or replace any broken or off-grade concrete sidewalk, curb and gutter. For sidewalk adjacent to Metro property, close all unused driveways with full height curb, 2-foot gutter, and sidewalk.


Explanation: The second sentence was added to the previous Council approved street vacation. Metro will close unused driveways adjacent to Metro property; however, the developer for District Square on the south side of Rodeo Road should be responsible for their driveways.
