## MOTION

Public health and safety related operations in the City of Los Angeles include the identification and regulation of visibility obstructions, such as bins and storage containers in the public rights of way.

Currently there are large storage containers that are placed on the streets of LA that are tied to property owners, business owners, contractors and/or developers. Division investigators, under the Bureau of Street Services Investigation and Enforcement Division, are responsible for improving the quality of life for the public by increasing cleanliness levels and making public rights of way more aesthetically pleasing.

There is a need to regulate and enforce large storage containers found on public streets. There are only a number of containers that are illuminated by reflector barricades. There is a need to better enforce regulations to prevent these storage containers from becoming an obstruction or public safety hazard.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the Board of Public Works be directed to report back to the City Council with a list of locations that identify existing storage containers on the streets of Los Angeles, with recommendations on how to prevent these containers from being in the public rights of way and on how the Bureau of Street Services Investigation and Enforcement Bureau can improve regulations over these visibility obstructions.
