

HOUSING COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the use of Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds for sidewalk repair in Council District Nine.

Recommendations for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Price – Wesson), SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:

1. REPROGRAM \$550,000 from the following CDBG projects in the amounts shown below to the CD 9 Sidewalk Program:

- b. Appropriate \$22,000 within Fund No. 100/76 Account No. 001010 Salaries.
 - c. Appropriate \$26,000 within Fund No. 100/78 Account No. 001010 Salaries.
 - d. Establish a new account entitled CD9 CDBG Sidewalk Repair and appropriate \$502,000 within the Sidewalk Repair Fund No. 57F.
3. AUTHORIZE resolution authority staff from the Bureaus of Engineering and Contract Administration to perform work on the CDBG CD9 Sidewalk project.
 4. AUTHORIZE the Los Angeles Housing and Community Investment Department to submit an amendment to the Consolidated Plan to effectuate this action and to prepare Controller instructions and/or make any technical adjustments consistent with this action, subject to the

approval of the Chief Legislative Analyst (CLA); and, AUTHORIZE the Controller to implement the instructions.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the CLA has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

On January 19, 2016, Council considered Motion (Price – Wesson) relative to the use of CDBG funds for sidewalk repair in Council District Nine. Motion states that sidewalks in the district are in a state of disrepair. CDBG funds in the amount of \$550,000 have been identified to repair sidewalks. The Bureaus of Engineering and Contract Administration will implement this project in partnership with the Coalition for Responsible Community Development. Motion recommends approval of the use of CDBG funds in the amount of \$550,000 for this purpose. Council referred Motion to the Housing Committee for consideration.

At its special meeting held February 3, 2016, the Housing Committee recommended that Council approve Motion's recommendations for the use of CDBG for sidewalk repair in Council District Nine.
