### **A PROPOSED GENERAL PLAN AMENDMENT TO REDESIGNATE SEVERAL STREETS ALONG HAZARD PARK AND THE UNIVERSITY OF SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA HEALTH SCIENCES CAMPUS WITHIN THE NORTHEAST LOS ANGELES COMMUNITY PLAN.**

Pursuant to the provisions of Sections 551, 555, 556 and 558 of the City Charter, transmitted herewith is the April 10, 2014 action of the City Planning Commission recommending approval of the General Plan Amendments to the Northeast Los Angeles Community Plan (Land Use Element) and Transportation Element, to redesignate six streets with modified street standards along Hazard Park and the University of Southern California Health Sciences Campus, as set forth in the attached exhibits.

The City Planning Commission, as evidenced by the attached Findings, has determined that the proposed General Plan Amendments and modified street standards are consistent with the City's General Plan.

The proposed General Plan Amendments were submitted to the Mayor whose recommendation will be forwarded to you as specified by Section 11.5.6 of the Los Angeles Municipal Code.

### **RECOMMENDATION**

1. **Concur** in the attached action of the City Planning Commission relative to its approval of the proposed General Plan Amendments for the Northeast Los Angeles Community Plan and Transportation Element; and

4. **Direct** Planning staff to revise the Community Plan and the Transportation Element in accordance with this action.

**RECOMMENDATION**


That the Mayor:
