REPORT relative to the feasibility of developing a cannabis enforcement program or task force.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Martinez - Huizar):

REQUEST the City Attorney, with the assistance of the Department of Cannabis Regulation and Los Angeles Police Department, to report on the feasibility of developing a cannabis enforcement program or task force, similar to the City Attorney's Tobacco Enforcement Program, that is responsible for conducting compliance checks related to the sale of cannabis products, and investigating and prosecuting cannabis retailers that are suspected of selling to minors.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

At the meeting held on June 23, 2020, your Rules, Elections, and Intergovernmental Relations Committee considered a Motion (Martinez - Huizar) relative to the feasibility of developing a cannabis enforcement program or task force.
