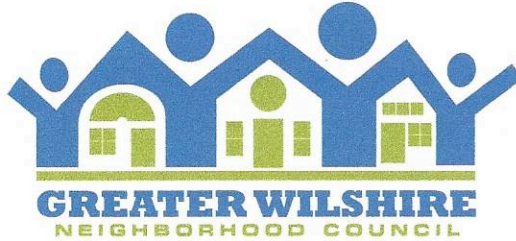

Brief Summary: The Greater Wilshire Neighborhood Council supports a “fix and release” plan for the repair of our tree-damaged sidewalks and the issuance of bonds to finance the repairs as long as there will be no new taxes. The GWNC supports the development of alternative plans (the 50/50 program, loan funds, Assessment Districts) that rely on the voluntary participation by property owners.

Additional Information: The GWNC supports property owners and the City being able to retain independent contractors and managers for sidewalk repairs. The GWNC supports the assessment of the status of our sidewalks and prioritizing the necessary repairs. The GWNC wants a well-funded, independent Oversight Committee established to ensure transparency throughout the process.



*The Greater Wilshire Neighborhood Council supports a "fix and release" plan for the repair of our tree-damaged sidewalks.*


*The City will issue bonds to finance the repairs. There will be no new taxes.*


