

PLANNING AND LAND USE MANAGEMENT (PLUM) COMMITTEE REPORT relative to coordination of off-site private development with Active Transportation Program (ATP) Grant Project streetscape and public realm improvements.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Huizar - Blumenfield):

INSTRUCT the Department of City Planning, in conjunction with the Bureau of Engineering, to coordinate private development off-site conditions so that streetscape and public realm improvement conditions are implemented consistent with the ATP project scope.

SUMMARY

At a regular meeting held on March 6, 2018, the PLUM Committee considered a Motion (Huizar - Blumenfield) relative to ensuring that any new private development around the ATP Project (Downtown Los Angeles Pedestrian and Cyclist Improvement Project) is coordinated with the ATP Project scope.
