TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE REPORT relative to amending Preferential Parking District (PPD) No. 28 to impose more restrictive parking restrictions.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Resolution (LaBonge - Koretz):

RESOLVE, pursuant to Los Angeles Municipal Code Section 80.58, to hereby amend PPD No. 28 to authorize the use of 1-HOUR PARKING 8:00 A.M. to 6 P.M., MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY; VEHICLES WITH DISTRICT NO. 28 PERMIT EXEMPT, for installation on all streets within the boundaries of PPD No. 28; and NO PARKING 8:00 A.M. to 6:00 P.M., MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY; VEHICLES WITH DISTRICT NO. 28 EXEMPT, for installation on all streets south of 8th Street within the boundaries of PPD No. 28 if valid petitions are received by the Los Angeles Department of Transportation requesting installation or requesting a switch from a different restriction currently posted; all other terms and conditions of PPD No. 28 shall remain unchanged.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

On April 23, 2014, Council considered Resolution (LaBonge - Koretz) relative to amending PPD No. 28. Resolution states that Council established the PPD on October 14, 2013 within the area of the City of Los Angeles bounded on the north by the centerline of Wilshire Boulevard; on the east by a line east of, and parallel to Muirfield Road extending from Wilshire Boulevard to the intersection of West Boulevard and Olympic Boulevard; on the south by the centerline of Olympic Boulevard; and on the west by the centerline of Highland Avenue. Resolution goes on to state that the Brookside Neighborhood has found that the original restrictions are too lenient and do not adequately address the parking problems in the neighborhood, therefore additional parking restrictions are needed. Resolution proposing "1-Hour Parking 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday through Friday;" and "No Parking 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday through Friday; Vehicles with District No. 28 permits exempt" regulation was referred by Council to Transportation Committee for consideration.

At its meeting held on May 28, 2014, the Transportation Committee recommended that Council approve the proposed modification of PPD. No. 28.
