TRANSPORTATION

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Los Angeles City Council, by Ordinance No. 157,425, effective March 18, 1983, provided for the establishment of Preferential Parking Districts by Resolution of the Council in each case, under Section 80.58 of the Los Angeles Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, on October 14, 2003, the City Council established Preferential Parking District (PPD) No. 28 that includes the Brookside Neighborhood in the residential area bounded: on the north by the centerline of Wilshire Boulevard; on the east by a line east of, and parallel to Muirfield Road extending from Wilshire Boulevard to the intersection of West Boulevard and Olympic Boulevard; on the south by the centerline of Olympic Boulevard; and on the west by the centerline of Highland Avenue; and


WHEREAS, since establishing PPD No. 28, the Brookside Neighborhood has found that the original restrictions are too lenient and do not adequately address the parking problems in the neighborhood; and


WHEREAS, the Brookside Neighborhood is seeking to add two new parking restrictions that would be available within PPD No. 28 if valid petitions are received by the Department of Transportation requesting installation or requesting a switch from a different restriction currently posted;


NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council, pursuant to Los Angeles Municipal Code Section 80.58, amends Preferential Parking District No. 28 to authorize the use of the following new parking restrictions if valid petitions are received by the Department of Transportation requesting installation or requesting a switch from a different restriction currently posted:

- "1 HOUR PARKING 8 AM to 6 PM, MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY; VEHICLES WITH DISTRICT #28 PERMIT EXEMPTED, for installation on all streets within the boundaries of PPD No. 28; and
- "NO PARKING 8 AM to 6 PM, MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY; VEHICLES WITH DISTRICT #28 EXEMPT, for installation on all streets south of 8th Street within the boundaries of PPD No. 28

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that all other terms and conditions of Preferential Parking District No. 28 remain unchanged.
