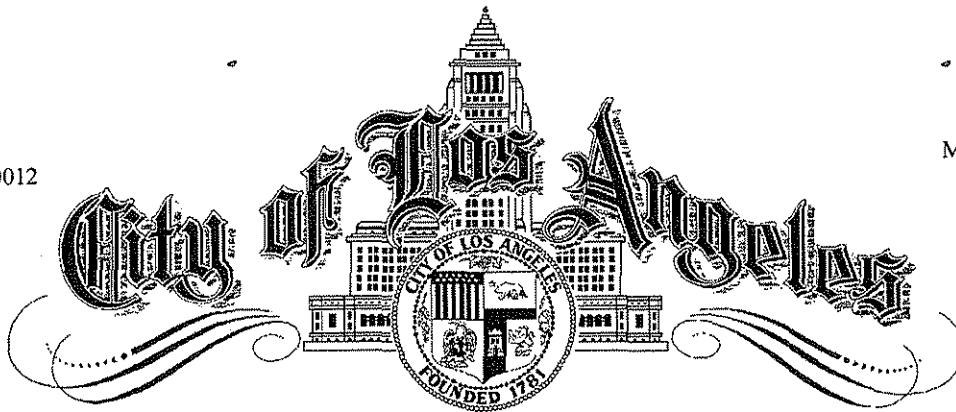

This matter arises from an incident involving a deputy city attorney that occurred on various dates during a litigation in which the deputy was representing the City of Los Angeles and its individual police officers. The litigation proceeded from February 2009 to June 2013.
