ARTS, PARKS, HEALTH, AGING AND RIVER COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the creation of a Northeast Los Angeles (NELA) Riverfront District as part of the NELA River Collaborative (RC).

Recommendations for Council action:

1. INSTRUCT the General Manager, Department of City Planning, or designee, to report to the Arts, Parks, Health, Aging and River Committee within 45 days on:
 - a. The feasibility of officially recognizing the NELA RC study area as the NELA Riverfront District.
 - b. The feasibility of developing a Specific Plan for the NELA Riverfront District, including necessary staffing resources, costs and timing.

2. INSTRUCT the General Manager, Economic and Workforce Development Department (EWDD), or designee, to report to the Arts, Parks, Health, Aging and River Committee within 45 days on staffing resources required to implement the NELA Riverfront District Vision Plan.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the EWDD. Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

On January 12, 2015, your Committee considered a January 7, 2015 report from the EWDD relative to the creation of a NELA Riverfront District as part of the NELA RC. The report, attached to the Council file, contains detailed information. During the discussion of this item, representatives from the EWDD provided a thorough overview of the report and responded to several related questions from the Committee members.

After providing an opportunity for public comment, the Committee recommended that Council approve the recommendations reflected above. This matter is now submitted to Council for its consideration.
