

HOMELESSNESS AND POVERTY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with the County of Los Angeles (County) and the Housing Authority of the City of Los Angeles (HACLA) to establish roles and align resources needed to develop permanent supportive housing.

Recommendations for Council action, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:

1. APPROVE the MOU as detailed in the October 16, 2017 City Administrative Officer (CAO) report, between the City, County, and HACLA, to finance permanent supportive housing for the chronically homeless and homeless population in the City.
2. AUTHORIZE the General Manager, Housing and Community Investment Department to execute the MOU on behalf of the City.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the CAO nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:


At its meeting held on October 18, 2017, the Homelessness and Poverty Committee considered an October 16, 2017 CAO report and Motion (Harris-Dawson - Huizar) relative to the MOU between the City, County, and HACLA to finance permanent supportive housing for the chronically homeless and homeless population in the City.

After providing an opportunity for public comment, the Committee recommended that Council approve the recommendations contained in the October 16, 2017 CAO report. This matter is now submitted to Council for its consideration.
