

PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the activities and status of the Los Angeles Police Department's (LAPD) Supplemental Police Account.

Recommendation for Council action:

APPROVE the Board of Police Commissioners report to Council dated June 19, 2014 (attached to the Council file), relative to the status and activities of the LAPD Supplemental Police Account for the period January through March, 2014.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the LAPD. Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

In a report to the Board of Police Commissioners dated June 3, 2014 (attached to the Council file), LAPD summarizes Supplemental Police Account activity for the period January through March, 2014. During this reporting period, there were 16 Account expenditures in which drugs or assets were seized. These expenditures resulted in 48 arrests and the seizure of \$55,009.00 in United States currency. Also seized were 11,024,194.77 grams of narcotics with a street value of \$110,643,975.64. On June 17, 2014, the Board approved LAPD's request.

At its meeting held August 8, 2014, the Public Safety Committee recommended that Council approve LAPD's report, as recommended by the Board of Police Commissioners.
