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PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD) Fiscal Year (FY) 2014-2015 Revolving Training Fund budget.

Recommendations for Council action, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:

1. APPROVE the distribution of funds for the LAPD FY 2014-15 Revolving Training Fund budget in the amount of \$1.5 million dollars.
2. AUTHORIZE the distribution of the funds from the FY 2014-15 Revolving Training Fund budget, as follows:

Executive Development:	\$234,000
Professional Development:	1,016,000
Tuition Reimbursement:	<u>250,000</u>
Total:	\$1,500,000

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the LAPD. Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

In a report to the Board of Police Commissioners dated May 30, 2014 (attached to the Council file), LAPD requests that Council approve the Department's FY 2014-15 Revolving Training Fund budget. According to LAPD, the purpose of the Revolving Training Fund is to oversee the receipt, retention, and disbursement of monies received from the State of California Commission on Peace Officer Standards and Training (POST), outside agencies, and the college affiliation program. Funding sources are POST reimbursements for Department-incurred expenses when presenting POST certified courses; POST reimbursements for per diem, tuition, and travel expenses incurred by LAPD personnel while attending POST-reimbursable courses; tuition fees paid by outside agencies whose employees attended training provided by LAPD; and, College affiliation program. Funds can be used for the payment of per diem, tuition, and travel expenses related to training; expense and equipment directly related to the delivery of training by LAPD personnel; and, short term rental of training facilities. On June 3, 2014, the Board approved LAPD's request.

At its meeting held August 8, 2014, the Public Safety Committee recommended that Council approve LAPD's FY 2014-15 Revolving Training Fund budget, as recommended by the Board of Police Commissioners.
