This Office has prepared and now transmits for your consideration the enclosed draft ordinance, approved as to form and legality. On August 22, 2014, this Office submitted a draft ordinance amending the Los Angeles Municipal Code (LAMC) in order to extend, for one year, the imposition of Tax Rate A to internet-based businesses (City Attorney report no. R14-0324). At the regularly-scheduled meeting of the Budget and Finance Committee on August 25, 2014, the Committee moved to revise the draft ordinance so as to extend the imposition of Tax Rate A to internet-based businesses through 2018. This office has prepared the revised draft ordinance and submits it for your consideration.
